Tuition:

Tuition is paid for the year or by semester. A two-semester commitment is required. Tuition covers facility expenses, web site management, music purchases, books, instructor fees, MMA shirt, large instrument purchases, classroom supplies, awards and many other expenses that are common to band and choir.

- 1 child tuition is \$300/year (\$175/semester).
- 2nd child tuition is \$250/year (125/semester).
- 3rd child tuition is \$200/year (\$100/semester).

There will be an \$50.00 drop fee for students not enrolling in the spring semester.
