REGISTRATION FEE:

Registration Fee – **Reenrolling Student:** \$250.00 per student enrolling by Feb. 24th
 \$350.00 per student enrolling Feb 25th- March 24th
 \$450.00 per student enrolling after March 24th

Registration Fee – **New Student:** \$250.00 per student

ANNUAL TUITION:

3K & 4K Half Day (8:00 – 12:00) \$ 7,400
 3K & 4K Full Day (8:00 – 2:45) \$ 9,550
 5K – 5th Grade (8:00 – 2:45) \$ 9,550
 6th – 12th Grade (8:00 – 3:15) \$10,445

Tuition may be paid either annually, bi-annually, or monthly using FACTS Tuition Management. Tuition for 2024-25 includes textbooks and some classroom supplies. Tuition **does not** include uniforms, yearbooks, athletic fees, activity and field trip fees or some student supplies.

MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT – 10% per student will be applied beginning with the third child enrolled.

FINANCIAL AID: Families desiring to apply for aid must first apply to Regents and then will need to submit a financial aid application by Feb. 24th. All applications will be evaluated through FACTS Grant & Aid.
