

**Policies and Procedures:** Participants - All camps are open to the community (Regents and non-Regents students) beginning with rising kindergarten. All grades listed on camps are for students entering those grades in the fall 2023.

All campers **MUST** complete registration prior to attending Summer at Regents. Please update your child's health history, emergency contact, and permission to treat form.

**Fees:** A non-refundable deposit of 1/2 the cost of the camp is required to secure your camper's spot. Remaining balance is due Friday prior to the beginning of the camp.



**Cancellations:** Camps with insufficient enrollment are subject to cancellation with a full refund. Notifications of cancellation will be made prior to the beginning of the camp.
